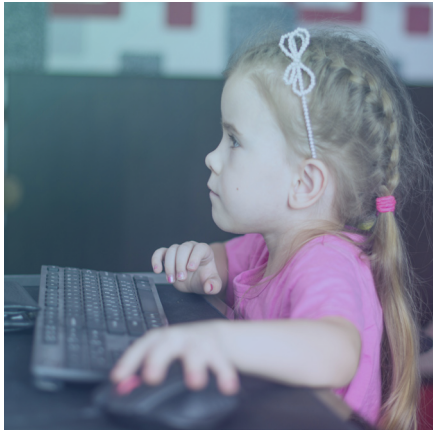
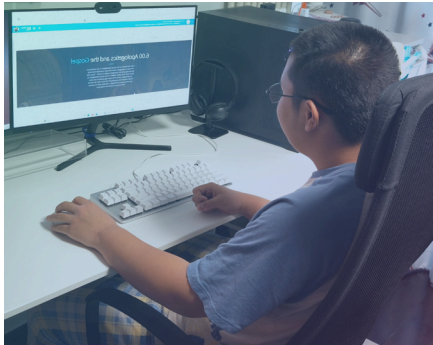
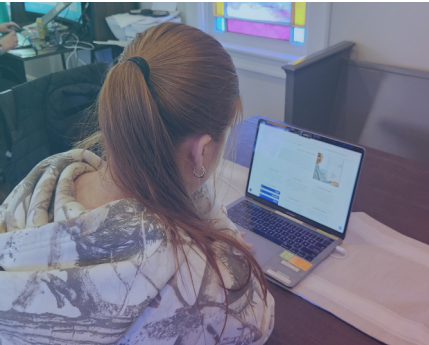

Christlikeness

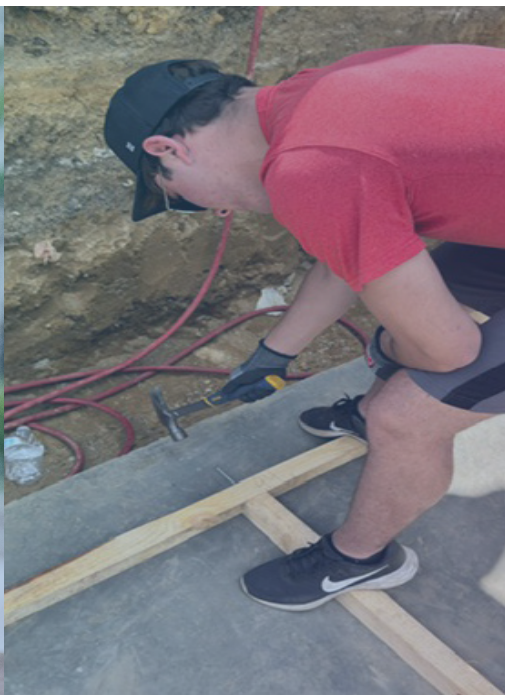

Biblical Stewardship & Service

Service and stewardship are two principal themes in scripture. With a focus on God's most prized creation (His people), we seek to effectively steward His resources through unparalleled support, flexibility and collaboration in our service, partnership in making disciples of Christ, and being fiscally responsible..

Student Focus

Students are at the heart of everything we do, which necessitates that success be defined by long-term student achievement. With a focus on the eternal over the temporal and a commission to make disciples of Christ, we prioritize the cultivation of a biblical worldview in students, student mastery of content, innovative strategies to support learning, and professional development for educators as a means of ensuring student success.



Academics

Our curriculum integrates Christian faith with academic content in every subject. This encourages students to view learning through the lens of God's truth and to live with reverence for Him. We do this by weaving three key biblical themes throughout our courses:

Creation: We explore the original, God-intended purpose of each topic or concept—how it was designed to function in a perfect world.

Fall: We identify how sin has distorted these ideas or practices, leading to brokenness or misuse.

Redemption: We consider how these ideas can be restored to reflect God's design and used for His glory.



Our instructors do more than grade assignments; they guide learning, hold students accountable, and respond with respect, all while encouraging both academic growth and spiritual development.

A key part of this support is our use of Discussion-Based Assessments (DBAs). These one-on-one conversations help students deepen their understanding, ask questions, and stay engaged. DBAs also give instructors insight into each student's needs and foster strong communication skills. Most importantly, they ensure students are truly mastering the material.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does asynchronous learning mean?

Sevenstar courses are asynchronous, meaning students can work on their own schedule rather than attending live classes. Courses start any Monday, allowing families to choose a start date that works best for them.

Can I take just one or two courses?

Yes, you can! We offer the flexibility to take individual courses so you can choose one or more courses to fit your needs.

Do courses include video lectures or live sessions?

While some courses have brief videos in the lesson content, our courses are not “video-based.” There are no scheduled live class sessions, and yet students do connect with their instructor in real-time throughout the semester through Discussion Based Assessments (DBA’s).

How much do courses cost?

Course prices vary depending on what you choose. Details regarding tuition, refunds, and any needed materials can be found on our website.

Can I preview a course before enrolling?

Absolutely! We offer full course demos so you can explore the content, structure, and platform before making a decision.

Embracing Flexibility for a Growing Family

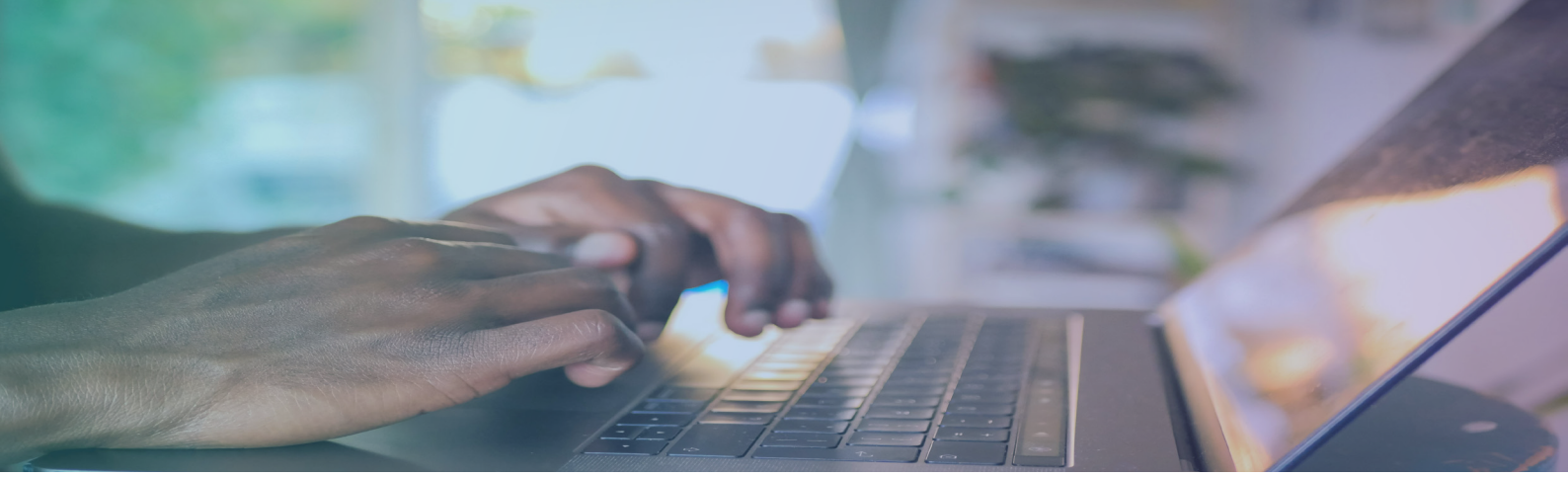
