ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

A student must have maintained a 3.0 average on a 4.0 scale in high school classes and be recommended by a high school counselor/principal or Sevenstar administrator to qualify. A qualified student who has completed the last semester of the sophomore year may begin taking Davis College courses offered through education partners, not to exceed five courses. A high school transcript of grades must be submitted to Davis College and approval for admission granted by a qualified Sevenstar Administrator. Students with a high school diploma may also apply if they attach a copy of the diploma.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Students are expected to participate in online activity weekly. Attendance is determined by activity during a workshop, either through discussions or submission of assignments. A student is reported absent for a workshop if there is not at least one submission (or posting) of an assignment or in a discussion forum assigned during that workshop. A student may be allowed three absences over the duration of the course. If a student exceeds the allowed absences (3) and does not officially withdraw before the last class session, the instructor is directed to issue the grade of "F." No refund will be provided.

CONTINUATION REQUIREMENTS

Qualified students must maintain a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale in Davis College courses to continue taking courses through the Sevenstar/Davis College program.
