

Credit Recovery Courses

The credit recovery version of courses give students the opportunity to make up credits through online courses. Students can earn credits for classes they have previously taken traditionally or online. Before enrolling, reach out to your school to confirm whether they want your student to complete a credit recovery course specifically or simply retake a standard course to recover credit — these are different options with different outcomes, and not all schools accept credit recovery courses.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do credit recovery courses work?

Each module of the course starts with a pre-test at the beginning of every module to identify the material students have not yet mastered. Each module also includes a post-test. If students successfully pass the pre-test in a module, they may bypass the lessons in that module and go straight to the post-test. Post-tests are always required, even if the student passes the pre-test.

How do courses engage students?

All courses include multimedia and links to enhance learning.

Is there a qualified instructor assigned to each student?

Yes, an online instructor from Sevenstar will facilitate the course and work with each student. Students are matched with an experienced instructor for the subject. Instructors will be available to answer questions, grade assignments, and keep students accountable for progress. On occasion, a local tutor may be required.

How long do credit recovery courses last?

Students have up to ten weeks to complete a credit recovery course and should devote at least 90 minutes every day to ensure successful completion of the course. Students will be scheduled assignments based on their start and end date. Assignments will be evenly distributed throughout the time frame to help students stay on pace. Parents or schools have the option of selecting dates that coincide with summer school or they can use the entire ten weeks.

Are credit recovery courses approved by the NCAA (for elite athletes)?

No, courses that allow students to exempt out of work are not accepted by the NCAA, but any student needing to recover credit to use for the NCAA can take our regular credit courses.

How is the integrity of the credit recovery program kept intact?

Semester exams must be proctored. Schools or parents must be willing to provide a proctor for these tests. The same expectations for integrity are expected as in any other Sevenstar or Christian school classes.

How much credit can I earn by taking a credit recovery course?

Students can earn up to a full credit for each of the courses.
